A - GENERAL INFORMATION

A1. VENUE

WELCOME TO TRENITINO,
WELCOME TO VAL DI FIEMME

Val di Fiemme is surrounded by particularly beautiful mountains such as the peaks of the Latemar, which are part of the UNESCO World Heritage

On the skis you can immerse yourself in the natural park of the Ski Center Latemar which includes 48 km of slopes that connect the villages of Pampeago, Predazzo and Obereggen. In the Bellamonte-Alpe Lusia ski area the slopes are near the Paneveggio Pale di San Martino Natural Park, one of the protected natural areas that has earned the Dolomites a special place in the UNESCO list

The slopes of Passo Rolle reveal an impressive view on the Pale di San Martino. And from the ski area of Alpe Cermis, with its long Olimpia slope (7.5 km), you can enjoy one of the most breathtaking panoramas in the Dolomites.

Other places where you can enjoy the view of these mountains that reflect the colors of the sunrise and sunset is in Lavazé-Oclini, where you can both ski and cross-country ski. Under the stars, there are two lightened slopes: Olimpia 3 at Alpe Cermis and the Obereggen slopes in the Ski Center Latemar.

A5. REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

The competition is regulated by the Regolamento Tecnico Federale (Technical Rules of the Italian Ski Federation), and it is included in the federal calendar FisiOnline.

A6. LIABILITY / INSURANCE

The organizer shall not be held liable for any damages caused to persons or material/equipment. All participants must be covered by sufficient health, accident and liability insurance. By submitting the entry from the respected National Federation confirms that all persons registered are covered by the appropriate insurance (in accordance with 1.5.1.2. IBU Event and Competition Rules.

A7. COVID-19 PROCEDURES

Due to the still dynamic and unpredictable COVID-19 situation including constant changes within the respective legislation/regulations, we ask to follow the rules strictly. The competition is organised in full compliance with the Covid-19 Protocol of the Italian Ski Federation. The current version is published here:

It is forbidden for spectators, friends, fans, parents and sponsors to enter the field of play.

COVID19 PREVENTION GUIDELINE

1) General safety and hygiene rules in the sports facility

a. The present COVID-19 prevention guideline was developed based on the current Italian COVID-19 measures in connection with the currently valid COVID-19 regulations and recommendations. For all further information about COVID-19- preventive measures, Mr. Roberto Brigadoi is appointed as prevention representative of the organizer.

b. The teams shall enquire independently about the applicable entry regulations to Italy. On the websites Covid-19, travellers (salute.gov.it) the latest regulations in force are available. At time of the issue of this invitation, the arrival to Italy from the OPA Countries is subject to the measures under the Decree of 14 December 2021. The new order of the Minister of Health provides that those arriving from countries on List C (OPA countries are listed within the List C) will have to present a negative molecular swab performed in the previous 48 hours or rapid antigenic test in the previous 24 hours, along with the certification of vaccination or recovery and Passenger Locator Form. Those who do not have a valid vaccination or recovery certification are required to complete a 5-day mandatory self-quarantine in addition to the swab. An exemption to the self-quarantine for entries for national sporting competitions is state on the webpage Exemptions - Covid-19, travellers (salute.gov.it).

c. Specific regulations have been developed in Italy for hotels accommodation and restaurant services (currently 2G rules are valid)

d. Participation to the competitions is only possible with a valid certificate (a 3G certificate, that is, from being tested, vaccinated, or having recovered). The relevant valid document must be presented at the race office and must be valid for the entire event.

e. The vaccination certificate, a confirmation from the doctor and the EU's "green pass" are valid as proof of vaccination.

f. PCR tests and rapid antigen tests are allowed for testing. PCR tests are valid for 72 hours, rapid official antigen tests for 48 hours.

g. Each athlete, trainee, coach and official must fill in the individual health questionnaire based on the attached form. For children under 18, the form must be signed by a parent or the legal guardian. The health questionnaire must be given to the OC representatives present at race office during the initial registration. The telephone numbers and email addresses of the respective coaches, trainers, athletes, and officials are required to enable contact tracing of the people present during the event in case of a subsequently identified COVID-19 case. The data will be destroyed after one month.

h. Each team captain is responsible for ensuring that contact tracing can take place in the event of an infection. Therefore, after the registration we ask to every team captain to bring to the race

office a daily list of athletes, trainers, team members etc. entering the competition area (health questionnaire for the team - form attached). The team members are required to measure their temperature and carry out superficial health checks and interviews on their own responsibility before arrival to the competition area.

i. Masks are mandatory for everyone everywhere on the entire event site. We recommend the usage of FFP2 masks. Only athletes can remove the mask during the sport performance.

j. We advise all participants to keep a minimum distance of 1 meter between other people both in indoor and outdoor areas.

k. Athletes, service-staff/coaches and other people present at the competition sites, who show symptoms of illness, are not allowed to enter the facilities/areas for training and competition and the organizer is to be informed.

l. Spectators are allowed to enter the competitions' venues on the specific identified tribunes. A 2G (vaccinated-recovered) Digital Green Certificate / Green pass is required and will be checked by OC officers.

2) General Rules for arrival and accommodation

b. Testing facilities in the area of Predazzo: if needed, the local organizer can help you to find an operating testing facility during the event

c. Measures in case of possible COVID-19 case

- If during the event a person suspects to have developed a COVID-19 infection, they must immediately contact the COVID-19 representative and the COVID-19 representative must immediately locate the possible case. All further steps/measures (separation, grounding, cancellation, etc.) must be carried out in coordination with the COVID-19 representative.
- If a COVID-19 suspect infection case develops after the event, it must be reported immediately to the COVID-19 representative. All persons involved in the competition must comply with the above measures. The organizer can expel people or groups from the event site at any time if they do not comply with these measures.

This Covid-19 measures can be adjusted depending on the circumstance and modified according to possible law or regulation changes.

B4. CEREMONIES, PRIZES

First three competitors in all categories will be awarded; only the awarded athletes can take part to the ceremony. The prizes will be awarded following the Covid rules.

B5. ACCREDITATION

- The event is regulated by the FISJ Rules and the present Rules, and the participants are obliged to conform these rules.
- Pre and Accreditation: all athletes, technicians and accompanying persons must proceed with the PRE-ACCREDITATION by sending the form "attachment1" by Thursday 10 February 2022 at 2.00 pm to the email

or via WhatsApp to the mobile +39-338.2009400. Only pre-accredited persons will then be accredited. The race office in Lago di Tesero will be open on Thursday 10th. in the afternoon and then from Friday 11th., every day from 7.30 onwards.

- Only one coach or team captain per country / committee / club will be able to access the race office (he must wear the FFP2 mask), to confirm the accreditations, bringing all the Health Questionnaires (which will be valid for the three days).

- Friday morning after checking the Health Questionnaires, all accredited persons will receive an identification element to be able to enter the field of play, all must wear the mask (it can be removed only at the time of the physical exercise).

- Also the GreenPass will be checked every day at the entrance of the field of play. In the meantime, if possible, also the body temperature will be measured, however, it is required that the responsible of each team guarantees that he has already checked it every morning as specified in the pre-registration document

- Bibs and identification elements distribution: Saturday and Sunday morning at the Race Office, to a single Responsible for each Country / Team, for athletes / technicians / accompanying persons.

- Access to the competition area will be allowed, for athletes only with bibs worn and to accredited technicians, coaches, judges, rescue personnel and technical support with identification, all wearing a mask.

- Access to the start: To access the starting area, everyone must wear a mask and bib or identification element.

- Behavior at the arrival: Athletes, at the end of their competition and before exiting the finish area, must by themselves: unload their firearms, take off the bib and leg bibs, and put them in the respective containers.






BIATHLON: 1,5km




BIATHLON: 2km
