






COURSE MAP Lap 2,5 Km






COURSE MAP Lap 3,3 Km

COURSE MAP Lap 3,750 Km








COURSE MAP Lap 5 Km

Covid -19



In order to ensure the health and safety for the athletes and team personnel, the LOC is working in accordance with the Regional and National Health regulations

as well as with FIS in accordance with the FIS COVID-19 Prevention Organiser Guidelines together with the World Health Organisation (WHO) on information and recommendations. The LOC and FIS Event Task Force has been established and is monitoring all developments. The corresponding arrangements are currently being put together in a separate document. Without exception, accreditations are only issued after the current Covid-19 preventive measures of the respective LOC have been fulfilled.
