

A.5 LIABILITY, INSURANCE

The organizer will not be held liable for accidents and damages including those of third parties. A proper insurance coverage (health, accident & liability insurance) for each member of a national federation will be taken for granted.

A.6 IMPORT AND EXPORT OF RIFLES AND AMMUNITION

All athletes and officials of a member federation of the EU who carry a rifle will also have to carry a European Firearms Pass.

Non-EU-citizens will have to complete a customs application upon arrival and will have to deposit a cash bail of 20% of the rifle's custom value. The cash bail will be refunded on the re-export of the rifle. Rifles and ammunition must be stored in the Biathlon Stadium.

A.7 REGULATIONS ON RADIO EQUIPMENT

Import, export and operation of radio equipment are **NOT FREE** of charge.

C.1 COMPETITION REGULATIONS

The competitions will be conducted according to the IBU E & C rules (IBU Regional Events Guidelines and Requirements) as in effect and FESA Biathlon Alpen Cup Determinations 2025 | 2026.

C.2 ATHLETE REGISTRATION IN IBU MEMBERCENTER

All participating athletes at Regional Events must be registered in the IBU Membercenter by IBU Member Federations – type of registration >New Athlete (Basic)<.

The deadline for registration of new athletes with basic registration is two weeks before the regional event.

- According to the IBU EB decision from 2nd March 2022 the participation of any Russian and Belarussian athletes or officials is not allowed.

START FEE:

- € 13,00 per athlete per competition for Alpen Cup nations
- € 23,00 per athlete per competition for Non-Alpen Cup nations
- We kindly ask you that the payment is made by the country coordinators for all competitors together.
 Payments will be possible, on Saturday morning and Sunday morning directly in the Competition Office (only per credit card or cash no money transfer possible).

C.4 COMMON WAXING

The International Biathlon Union (IBU) has implemented a full ban of ski preparation products containing fluor at all its event series from 2023/2024 season onward. Thus common waxing with random ski control will be used at FESA Biathlon Alpen Cup 2026 Hochfilzen (AUT).

Common Waxing means the same ski preparation for all Athletes and will be implemented according to the "Common Waxing protocol for IBU events". Detailed information will be communicated closer to the event.

C.9 IBU TRAVEL CONTRIBUTION TO NFs

IBU contributes travel costs of € 100,00 per youth and junior athlete per event for the host NF, maximum € 2.500,00. The IBU contributes € 200,00 per youth and junior athlete for guest NF. The maximum contribution is € 4.000,00 per participating guest NF. The travel contribution is based on competition results and will be transferred by IBU to participating NFs and should be used to cover / support the travel expenses of athletes / teams.
